The most important takeaway is that the NREL estimates that BESS costs will start to fall this year in its 'low' and 'mid' cost projections, with an increase over the next few years forecast in its 'high' scenario, visualised in the graph above. How much does Bess cost? The cost of BESS has fallen significantly over the past decade, with more precipitous drops in recent years: This is nearly a 70% reduction in three years, owing to falling battery pack prices (now as low as \$60-70/kWh in China), increased deployment, and improved efficiency. What factors affect the cost of a Bess system? Several factors can influence the cost of a BESS, including: Larger systems cost more, but they often provide better value per kWh due to economies of scale. For instance, utility-scale projects benefit from bulk purchasing and reduced per-unit costs compared to residential installations. Costs can vary depending on where the system is installed. Why is Bess so expensive compared to a lithium-ion battery? A big driver of the fall in BESS costs will be a decline in the costs of the battery cells and packs themselves, which can make up half the cost of a lithium-ion BESS. How much does Bess cost in China? It is nonetheless still eye-opening to note just how big those differences in cost are. The average for a turnkey system in China including 1-hour, 2-hour and 4-hour duration BESS was just US\$101/kWh. In the US, the average was US\$236/kWh and in Europe US\$275/kWh, more than double China's average cost.
