How is public procurement regulated in Switzerland?The Swiss Confederation and the 26 cantons each have the power to enact their own public procurement legislation for public procurements by entities on a national and cantonal/municipal level within the framework provided by international and national law. Thus, public procurement in Switzerland is regulated on three levels: What is Switzerland's government procurement platform?Switzerland's official platform for government procurement is simap , a centralized repository for tenders from the federal government, cantons, and communes. The platform provides access to a wide range of procurement opportunities, including construction projects, goods, and services. Where can I find e-procurement notices in Switzerland?Most of the public procurement notices and many of the contract award notices at federal, cantonal and municipal level are published online on .simap . Apart from that, e-procurement is still not very well developed in Switzerland. What is the Swiss Federal Office of Energy (SFOE)?The Swiss Federal Office of Energy ("SFOE") is the country's competence centre for all issues relating to energy supply and energy use at the DETEC. The SFOE creates the prerequisites for a sufficient, crisis-proof, broad-based, economic and sustainable energy supply. What are the different types of procurement procedures in Switzerland?Swiss public procurement law knows four different procurement types of procedures: Open procedure („offenes Verfahren"): All interested providers/suppliers may submit an offer after the planned procurement has been published (Art. 18 FAPP/IAPP). How does a cost-covering fee affect electricity production in Switzerland?Further, the introduction of a cost-covering fee for feed-in to the electricity grid, in order to subsidise new renewable energy sources in Switzerland, disadvantaged traditional hydro electricity producers.
