According to BW ESS' website, the 14 batteries which are the subject of the green loan are between 5 MW and 20 MW in scale and "generally" have an hour of storage capacity. BW ESS is active in the UK, Australia, Italy, Germany, and Sweden. Why is BW ESS partnering with Nordea?
