Which Bess projects have cleared an auction in Poland? These projects represent the largest BESS portfolio to ever clear an auction in Poland. The Greenvolt Group has utility scale wind, solar, and BESS projects in 15 countries and also operates in the important segments of distributed generation, and the production of energy from sustainable biomass. How much does a Bess project cost? The contracts cover 17 years of capacity payment obligation and establish that the service will be remunerated at a fixed (CPI indexed) price of PLN 244.90/kW/year (EUR56.3/kW/year) during the entirety of the contract periods. Should Bess invest in the Polish capacity market? Moreover, preferential or market loans could finance up to 100% of eligible costs.
