After the liberalisation of the ancillary services market in June , prices initially fluctuated wildly, but have settled at an attractive level. And battery revenues, for front-of-the-meter installations, are very attractive. How many Bess market units won the auction?Even more surprising was their performance in the December auction: out of the 245 Market Units that won the main auction for the delivery year, 82 were identified as BESS. Why should you invest in Bess in ?The exhibition showcased a range of innovations, from advanced photovoltaic systems to cutting-edge energy storage technologies, reflecting the dynamic growth of the renewable energy sector. The activation of Poland's Frequency Containment Reserve (FCR) market on June 14, , has markedly enhanced the attractiveness of BESS investments.
